The Algonquin Resort Golf Course Fact Sheet

Since the turn of the century, *Score* golf magazine has ranked The Algonquin Resort Golf Course the best in New Brunswick and listed it among the top 10 Oceanside courses in North America and the top 100 courses in Canada.

The historic course first opened in 1894 and was built to suit the times, capable of accommodating 30-40 golfers. In the 1920s, Donald Ross redesigned the course and added an “Executive Nine,” providing an alternative to a full round of golf.

As the game gained popularity, the course was again updated and redesigned by renowned Canadian golf course designer, Tom McBroom. The course reopened on July 15, 2000 featuring a stunning downhill par three 12th hole overlooking Passamaquoddy Bay that the *Globe and Mail* says is among the top nine holes in the country.
